

# NOWACO Cookie Policy

## 1 Information about this policy

This Cookie Policy describes the different types of cookies that may be used in connection with NOWACO's website and how you can manage them.

We may change the Cookie Policy at any time. Changes in the Cookie Policy will become effective when we make the revised Cookie Policy available on or through our website.

## 2 What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that websites save on your computer or mobile device in order to recognise the computer/mobile device and/or remember a selection/setting the next time you visit the website. A cookie is a passive file and cannot spread a computer virus, install programs or spy on you in any other way. Other websites cannot read cookies saved by this website.

### 2.1 How long are cookies stored?

A cookie always deletes itself after a varying number of months, but it is renewed automatically every time you visit the website.

#### **a. System Cookies:**
